# Doing Life with The Spirit The Person of the Holy Spirit - Plus

I believe because He is the most Misunderstood AND the most Controversial...

Easy to conceptualize:

God the Father...

Jesus the Son...

Holy Spirit is an unseen entity who is not described in anthropomorphic terms...

Can we biblically support our belief about the Holy Spirit?

**Pneumatology** 

Why is this important?

- 1. We don't want to believe something that is not biblical.
- 2. We need to know WHY we believe what we believe AND be prepared to defend it.

John 16: 5 - 7 (NLT)

"But now I am going away to the one who sent me, and not one of you is asking where I am going. <sup>6</sup> Instead, you grieve because of what I've told you. <sup>7</sup> But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the **Advocate** won't come.

Comforter (KJV) Helper (NASB)

If I do go away, then I will send him to you.

This is a Relational exchange...

Helper – He is personally sent to actively assist.

**How Jesus Described the Holy Spirit** 

1. The Spirit of Truth

## John 14: 16 & 17 (NASB)

I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, so that He may be with you forever; <sup>17</sup> the Helper is the **Spirit of truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him; but you know Him because He remains with you and will be in you.

## John 16: 12 & 13 (NASB)

"I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear them at the present time. <sup>13</sup> But when He, the **Spirit** of truth, comes, He will **guide** you into all the truth; for He will not **speak** on His own, but whatever He **hears**, He will **speak**; and He will **disclose** to you what is to come.

Spirit – pnema:

- A. Expose error and false doctrine
- B. Air set in motion, breeze, breath
- 2. Counselor

John 15: 26 (NASB)

"When the Helper comes,

Counselor (HCSB) Comforter (KJV)

whom I will send to you from the Father, namely, the Spirit of truth who comes from the Father, He will testify about Me,

Helper - paraklētos: One sent, given, & received. Brings active help.

- A. Advocate legal counselor
- B. Counselor giving of advice
- C. Intercessor Romans 8: 27
- 3. Teacher

## John 14: 25 & 26 (NASB)

"These things I have spoken to you while remaining with you. <sup>26</sup> But the Helper, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in My name, He will **teach** you all things, and remind you of all that I said to you.

#### Teach - didaskō:

- A. We are life-long learners.
- B. Validates Scripture.

## 2 Peter 1: 20 & 21 (NASB)

... know this first of all, that no prophecy of scripture becomes a matter of someone's own interpretation, <sup>21</sup> for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

# Prophecy – *prophēteia*:

Practical instructions on the interpretation of Scripture, but particularly on the Kingdom of God and the Gospel.

## 4. Convicter

## **John 16: 8 (NASB)**

...And He, when He comes, will **convict** the world regarding sin, and righteousness, and judgment:

- A. Holy Spirit convinces the world of sin.
- B. The Holy Spirit convicts YOU of sin.
