1. He's the RULER, MASTER, LEADER, OWNER... of ALL creation!

Colossians 1: 15 - 17 (ESV)

- He is **God**.
- He is **creator**.
- He is **sustainer**.

Isaiah 40: 12 (NLT)

Who else has held the oceans in his hand?

Who has measured off the heavens with his fingers?

Who else knows the weight of the earth or has weighed the mountains and hills on a scale?

2. Jesus loves you!

Zephaniah 3: 17 (NLT)

For the LORD your God is living among you. He is a mighty savior.

He will take delight in you with gladness. With his love, he will calm all your fears.

He will rejoice over you with joyful songs.”

Philippians 2: 6 - 11 (NLT)

Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to.

*⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine **privileges**; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, ⁸he humbled himself in obedience to God and **died a criminal's death on a cross**.*

⁹ Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names,

¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

¹¹ and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Isaiah 40: 26 (NLT)

Look up into the heavens. Who created all the stars?

*He brings them out like an army, one after another, **calling each by its name**.*

*Because of his great power and incomparable strength, **not a single one is missing**.*
